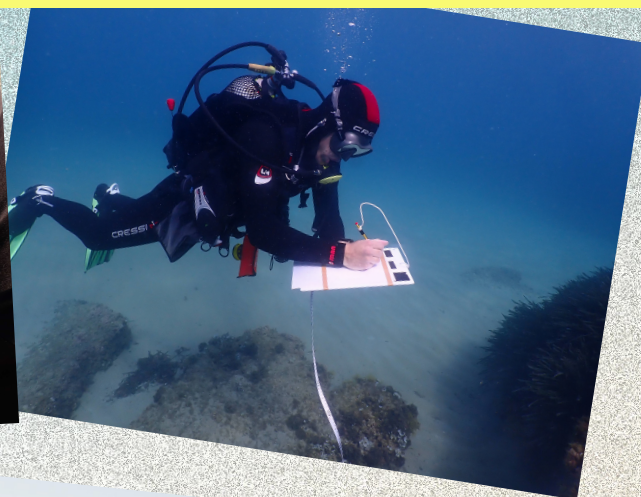


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The Leader

KONAK ŞEHIT ÖMER HALISDEMİR SCIENCE AND ART CENTER

Konak Şehit Ömer Halisdemir is a special education institution that provides supporting education for gifted students. It has about 800 students between the ages of 8-18 and 35 teachers. The gifted students are chosen through a two-level diagnostic process. Our disadvantaged students continue to receive regular education during their primary, secondary, and high school terms. Our main objective is to develop their individual talents and to maximize their capacities. Our students receive differentiated, enriched, and project-based education according to their talents in Music, Art, and General Mental Ability. In our institution, there are two FabLab Industry 4.0, technology and design, coding, English, life skills, philosophy, physics, chemistry, art, music workshops, a music technologies studio, and a Math Illusion Museum, which is the largest in Europe. Our students actively engage in these workshops.
